WHY CHURCH PLANTING?

Biblical mandate and example

Jesus gives the mandate in the Great Commission to make disciples. This is carried all through the book of Acts by planting churches.

2 It reaches the unchurched

Statistics and experience demonstrate that new churches are uniquely effective at reaching the unchurched and de-churched.

3 The number of unchurched is growing

There are upwards of 120 million non-churched people in America. Just in the past 10 years, an estimated 38 million people in the U.S. have left the church. That is more than the entire population of Canada. At the same time, the number of churches closing their doors is more than 2 times the number of new churches planted.

1. Evangelical


AFLC Home Missions

Coaching & Conferences


We have been able to benefit from networking, coaching, assessment, and conferences provided both within and outside of the AFLC.
